

GENERAL TEACHING GOAL: (Matthew 22:36-40; Romans 7:12)

- Love God and love people

SHOW TWO PATHS IN LIFE: (Psalms 1)

- Blessing or curse

TEACH THE PROGRESSION OF SIN: (James 1:14-15)

- Lust to temptation to sin to death (every sin contains the seed of death)

IDENTIFY THE CONSEQUENCES OF SIN: (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14; Revelation 20:12&15)

- Suffering, dishonor, death, etc.

SHOW THE SOURCE OF SIN: (Proverbs 4:23; Matthew 15:18-20a)

- Man’s heart (inner person)

BIBLICAL TEACHING ON SEX:

- Teach the proper role of sex: (Genesis 2:24; Hebrews 13:4)
- Warn about improper sex: (Deuteronomy 5:18; Proverbs 6:32-35; 1 Corinthians 6:18; 1 Thessalonians 4:3)
- Give illustrations of good and bad responses to sexual temptation:
 - Good-Joseph (Genesis 39:5-9&12)
 - Bad-David (2 Samuel 11:2-18:14; 1 Kings 1:5-6)
 - Temptation & sin (2 Sam 11:2-6)
 - Attempted cover up, plan A (2 Sam 11:8-9&11&13)
 - Murder, plan B (2 Sam 11:14-17)
 - Attempted cover up, plan C (2 Sam 11:27)
 - Confession, plan D (2 Sam 12:13-14)
 - Son Amnon rapes daughter Tamar (2 Sam 13:1&11&14)
 - Son Absalom kills Amnon (2 Sam 13:28)
 - Absalom attempts to kill David (2 Sam 15:10)
 - Absalom rapes 10 concubines (2 Sam 16:21-22)
 - Joab kills Absalom (2 Sam 18:14)
 - Adonijah attempts to kill David (1 Ki 1:5-6)

SUGGESTED TEACHING SEQUENCE: (How to teach children from the Bible)

- Summarize Scriptural teaching (applicable verses)
- Look for biblical illustrations of obedience & disobedience
- Analyze the biblical examples (talk about what happened and why)
- Look for contemporary examples (what would it look like today?)
- Identify how to prevent or avoid sinning
