Introduction

Memphis Stone & Gravel Company has developed the Good Neighbor Trucking Policy (GNTP) to address issues associated with trucks moving to and from its operations. This Supplement has site-specific rules to address Memphis Stone & Gravel Company's Anderson Mine.

Off-Site Rules

1. All loaded trucks must be directed to Highway 51 when exiting the main Anderson Mine entrance at Pleasant Hill Road.
2. Trucks traveling to the plant's scale house from the Tillman-Sawyer-Bell Property shall exit and travel Byhalia Road to Getwell Road to Pleasant Hill Road to the plant entrance.
3. Absolutely no trucks will be allowed to park on Pleasant Hill Road or Byhalia Road before entry gates open. Memphis Stone & Gravel Company will designate safe parking areas and if it is full, trucks must bypass the entrance(s) until room becomes available.
4. Be advised of stop signs and warning signs.
5. Hauling operations must stop during church services and/or funeral processions from New Bethel MB Church.

On-Site Rules

1. Hours may vary at the Anderson Mine, but typically last daylight to dark, Monday-Saturday. The plant scale house will have the current hours of operation.
2. Tillman-Sawyer-Bell Property: Truck loading hours will be as follows: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
