Introduction

Memphis Stone & Gravel Company and its sister company Lehman-Roberts Company have developed the Good Neighbor Trucking Policy (GNTP) to address issues associated with trucks moving to and from its operations. This Supplement has site-specific rules to address Memphis Stone & Gravel Company's North Plant Mine, including its satellite operations (i.e., Bradley, Duke, and Griffin/Murphy) and Lehman-Roberts Company's Plant 2.

Off-Site Rules

1. All trucks must be directed to the Millington-Arlington Road when exiting the plant.
2. Trucks traveling to and/or from the Bradley Property shall be limited to state and federal highways, except that Deadfall Road south of the mine and the connecting segment (only) of Godwin Road may be used as the access road.
3. Absolutely no trucks will be allowed to park on Millington-Arlington Road or Deadfall Road before entry gates open. Memphis Stone & Gravel Company will designate safe parking areas and if it is full, trucks must bypass the entrance until room becomes available.

On-Site Rules

1. Days of operation may vary at the North Plant Mine and Plant 2, but are typically Monday-Saturday. The plants' scale house will have the current hours of operation.
2. Bradley Property and Duke Property: Truck loading hours are as follows: Monday through Saturday, 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., limited to daylight hours.
