ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 (based on a 4.0 scale);
- Must enroll in either a 4-year undergraduate program or a 2-year community college no later than fall 2018;
- Applications, including transcripts and letters of recommendation, must be received or postmarked by February 2, 2018. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered;

- Scholarship checks will be issued directly to the college institution on behalf of the student;

In the event a student's tuition is paid in full from other sources, the scholarship award shall be directly to the student for payment of books, materials, computers or other approved educational-related expenses. Students to whom the award is paid directly must provide sufficient receipts documenting their expenses prior to receiving payment of the scholarship award.
