Ronald McDonald House® of Memphis is a “home-away-from-home” for families who are in Memphis while their child is receiving treatment for cancer or another catastrophic illness at St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital. Since 1991, Ronald McDonald House Charities® of Memphis has been giving families the gift of “Home” completely free of charge. Since opening, more than 6,400 families have been given a warm bed, a warm meal, and when needed, a warm hug from another family fighting the same battle. Through the generous support we receive from the community, Ronald McDonald House is able to give families the most valuable commodity of all: more time. That means more time for playing, more time for laughing, and more time to say “I love you.”

Ronald McDonald House of Memphis is an independent, community supported, 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization. To supplement our core staff, we have over 1,000 volunteers who cover daily and weekly shifts at the House, as well as provide help during our major fundraising events. Although Ronald McDonald House® of Memphis receives generous support from McDonald’s and St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital, more than 50 percent of the annual budget is donated by individuals, businesses, churches, clubs, and organizations in the community.
