Position: ReStore Associate -Driver
Part Time, Memphis, TN

Starting Hourly Wage: \$12 per hour

The Restore Driver is responsible for driving Habitat vehicles to pick up, load and unload donated goods from donors. Each donation is required to be picked up safely, loaded with care, and brought back to the ReStore and unloaded in our processing area.

Roles & Responsibilities

- Drive and/or ride in truck to pick up donated goods and operate vehicles within local, state, and federal guidelines
- Complete routes in efficient manor communicating Estimated Time Arrival with donors and ReStore Scheduler
- Load and unload all donated materials weighing up to up to 80 pounds to max capacity of pick-ups, and minimize damage to merchandise
- Complete paperwork, receipts and online confirmation of all pick-ups
- Conduct inspection and report any needed truck maintenance or incidents to Operations Manager immediately
- Unload donations at ReStore after pick-up and bring to floor department
- Other duties as deemed necessary in the day-to-day operations of the ReStore.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work

This is a part-time position. Days and hours of work are Monday through Saturday based on the needs of the business. Evening and weekend work may be required as job duties demand.

- Previous retail or customer service experience
- Valid State Driver's License

- Forklift certification (possess or have the ability to obtain)
