1. Listen to, repeat, and create simple prayers.
2. Identify characters in picture books.
3. Recognize their name in print.
4. Listen without interrupting.
5. Retell stories read to them.
6. Speak in phrases and simple sentences.
7. Follow 1-2 step directions.
8. Identify reality and fantasy.
9. Predict what will happen next in a story.
10. Ask simple questions.
11. Use scribble writing to represent word/concept.
12. Actively participate in role-play.
13. Recognize and follow simple directions.
14. Answer simple questions about a story.
15. Share a personal experience.

Math Curriculum**

We provide learning experiences to help each preschool student ...

1. Recognize that God has created an ordered universe.
2. Identify numbers 0-20.
3. Count to 20.
4. Count daily using the calendar.
5. Identify and repeat simple patterns.
6. Compare objects using words more/less/fewer and same/different.
7. Sort objects by color, size, shape.
8. Use words that indicate direction up/down, over/under, above/below, in/out.
9. Match pairs.
10. Identify objects position first/last.
11. Recognize and manipulate an object's position (building blocks, assembling puzzles).

1. Understand that each of us is a special gift from God.
2. Identify community helpers.
3. Remember simple rules.
4. Repeat a simple story.
5. Show respect for Christian and American flag (Pledge of Allegiance).
6. Identify holidays (celebrations).
7. Repeat what he/she hears.
8. Help others.
9. Identify forms of transportation.
10. Share/take turns with classmates.
11. Play with others without supervision.
12. Identify roads, bodies of water, buildings, etc. during play.
13. Role-play.
14. Recognize changes in weather.
15. Describe a range of people who make up a community.
16. Listen quietly to a story.

1. Recognize that God created all living and non-living things.
2. Identify colors.
3. Sort objects by color, shape, size.
4. Identify shapes.
5. Use magnifying glass and magnets.
6. Predict patterns.
7. Identify parts of the body.
8. Use weather chart (identify kind of weather).
9. Recognize days of the week.
10. Identify seasons.
11. Identify types of animals/habitats.
12. Explore textures.
13. Identify different kinds of sound.
14. Identify the five senses.

## **Preschool Art Curriculum**

### **Baton Rouge Lutheran School 2015-2016**

We provide learning experiences to help each preschool student ...

1. Recognize that God's world is full of colors, forms, shapes, and textures.
2. Discover the relation of arm movement to circular, horizontal, and diagonal marks and lines on paper.
3. Name scribbles as images.
4. Use shapes that are geometric to create forms.
5. Play with building blocks (a low level experience with form) as a precursor to sculpture.
6. Demonstrate an awareness that textures exist and that objects feel different from each other.
7. Develop a repertoire of visual symbols by drawing daily with crayons, markers, and paint on paper.
8. Match or group various shades of a color, verbally attaching a basic color name to them (red, yellow, blue, green, orange, purple, brown, or black).
9. Demonstrate a back-and-forth brush movement while painting.
10. Rinse brush when changing to a different color.
11. Use appropriate amounts of glue in attaching items to paper.
12. Cut out basic drawn shapes on paper.
13. Recognize that additional colors can be mixed from the three primary colors and white.
14. Illustrate Bible stories, read-aloud books, events, people, and seasons in a manner appropriate for their developmental age.
15. Clean up art table.
16. Create three-dimensional objects from clay.
17. Use appropriate pressure with drawing implements, especially paint brushes.

Physical Education Curriculum

We provide learning experiences to help each preschool student ...

1. Know that Jesus made their bodies, and He wants them to take care of them.
2. Show Jesus' love while moving and playing.
3. Move up and down and fast and slow.
4. Kick soft objects.
5. Catch rolling and bouncing balls.
6. Jump over lines or shapes on floor.
7. Move as directed.
8. Walk in a straight line, one behind the other.
9. Run fast to a specified goal.
10. Repeat actions shown by teacher.
11. Share and take turns.
12. Hop on one foot.
13. Gallop with preferred foot.
14. Use scarves, balloons, balls, beanbags, and other manipulatives.
15. Use playground equipment correctly.
16. Strike and volley light objects with hands.
17. Vertically toss a small, light object.
18. Throw a small object from an overhand position.
19. Recognize that movement is fun.
20. Look forward to physical activity.
21. Avoid other's personal space.
22. Control an object with another person.
23. Take care of playground equipment.

Library Curriculum**

We provide learning experiences to help each preschool student ...

1. Learn to use their Christian values to judge the actions of the characters.
2. Learn to sit quietly, listen to the story being read, and pay attention to the illustrations.
3. Have the opportunity to interact with the librarian, discussing the story and illustrations.
4. Be invited to relate the story to personal experience.
5. Have the opportunity to participate in refrains or repetitions.
6. Find enjoyment in the books.
7. Recognize the library as a place where books are kept, used, and enjoyed.
8. Reinforce recognition of colors and numbers.
9. Reinforce the weekly theme or focus of the class.



**Preschool  
Music Curriculum**

We provide learning experiences to help each preschool student ...

1. Praise God with music.
2. Lead worship through singing in Chapel, church services, and daily Jesus Time.
3. Recognize fast and slow tempos and demonstrate through movement.
4. Recognize loud and soft dynamics and demonstrate through movement.
5. Identify and demonstrate the difference between a singing voice and a speaking voice.
6. Play a variety of classroom instruments to the steady beat.
7. Move to show differences between duple and triple meters.
8. Recognize higher and lower pitches.
9. Identify same/different in musical styles and sections in music.
10. Understand the concept of echo singing.
11. Experience a wide variety of musical styles including sacred and secular.
12. Understand that the gift of music and singing is from God.
