Mon.	Book: <u>Exactly the Opposite</u> Up/Down Ask the children to raise their arms, feet, hands and head up, then place them down again. Dance: "Up And Down A Mountain" (Sally The Swinging Snake cd) Introduce the letter Ww. The class will sing along with the Animal Alphabet Friend "Wackford Walrus." Introduce the color and shape.	PEEK Lesson 116 Talk about all, some and none. Follow directions containing all, some and none. Run a race using short and long steps.	Sing the "Good Morning Song" Tell our Bible story while looking at our poster. Each child will pick a friend with whom to say the Bible verse. Close in prayer.
Tues.	Book: <u>Opposites</u> Hard/Soft Hard and soft items will be placed inside a "feel" box and have the children feel for an example of each to pull out. Sing: "Opposites" (Start Smart) Sing "ABCs." Look at the alphabet on the wall and each child will have a turn to point to the letter Ww. Identify who is wearing green today.	A Beka Week #37 No. Recog.: 10 Counting: 1-25 <i>Wkbk pg. 123</i> Count out a variety of 10 picnic items, including plastic food, dishes, cups and utensils. Count out 10 ants that come to join in on the picnic.	Sing the "Good Morning Song" In our Bible story today, there was a man who could not hop or walk or run. The man was lame. The man had kind friends who took him to see Jesus. Jesus was kind to the man and made him well. Today we will use a puppet and talk about what Jesus did to be kind to a man who couldn't walk. Close in prayer.
Wed.	Book: <u>Archibald's Opposites</u> Big/Little Take big and little steps around the room. Dance: "Song About Slow, Song About Fast" (Walter Worm Cd) Book: <u>My "w" book</u> Each child will count out 10 green paper ovals and glue them on a sheet of paper.	PEEK Lesson 117 Talk about legs and compare 4-legged animals to 2-legged birds. Stand on one leg and hop on one foot. Earn a hand stamp by asking the question, "What is in your bag?" Move through an obstacle course.	Sing the "Good Morning Song" Today the class will build a house and talk about some kind friends who took a lame man to see Jesus. Say the Bible verse to a friend. Close in prayer.

Sing the "Good Morning Song" The class will play a relay game and talk about ways friends are kind to each other. Each child will name one of their friends' name. Say the Bible verse with your eyes closed. Close in prayer.
Fri.	Book: <u>What the Sun Sees, What the Moon Sees</u> Day/Night Have pictures of the sun, moon and stars on the computer and ask the children to identify them by day and night. Today we will review the items in the Sound Box that start with the letter Ww. How many items are in the Sound Box?	PEEK Lesson 118 Learn about homes for animals (barn) and people (house/apartment). Answer questions about what is done and found in various rooms of homes.	Sing the "Good Morning Song" Color and put stickers on the activity page with children. Review our Bible verse. Close in prayer.
