

Drawing and Painting: Summer Assignments

1. **Create a drawing/ or painting of an extremely close-up view of something.** Emphasis on creating a range of value and showing texture. Use only pencil. Size 8x10 to 18x24. (example: close up of a row of button holes, a zipper and a seam., etc.)
2. Create a drawing of the **clothing and objects in your closet.** Use only pen. Size 11x 14 to 18 x 24
3. **Do a drawing of an unusual interior;** looking inside a cabinet, a drawer, refrigerator, Purse, back-pack, inside your car . . . use your imagination. Use any medium. 11x14 to 18x24.
4. Set up a **still life** of glass cups/ bottles with water in them of different heights. Try to use different sides of glasses too. Create an interesting composition of glasses on a plain surface. You may want to take a photo of the glasses in case you need to set up your still- life again. **Using only black and white (pencil or charcoal)**; include cast shadows, highlights, overlapping of glasses, a focal point, any reflections, etc... size 11x14 to 18 x24

● **Binder/ Artist Journal:** Begin a collection of what inspires you. I call it the "Inspiration Resource Collection". You will need to collect postcards, flyers, cut outs from magazines, computer print outs, etc. Attach your collected pictures of artwork to pages (8 1/2 x 11/printer paper) and write what you like about the image next to it, you will need to complete 8 pages.

The above assignments should be high quality work and you should be able to use them in your breath section of your portfolio that you submit. *You may work from photos as long as you take them yourself.* Failure to complete summer work and turn it in on time may result in you being dropped from the school year 2017-2018 AP Studio Art Course.

2D Design : PHOTOGRAPHY: Summer Assignments

1. **Capture a SERIES (20 or more) portraits or self-portraits.** There should be some type of theme between the photos in your series. Print on a contact sheet in black and white (this can be done at Walgreens), 4 pics per page. Save your jpegs.
2. **Capture a SERIES (20 or more) of moments captures during the July 4th celebrations.** This can include anything from portraits, still-life, food, etc... be creative with the angles that you use in your photos. Print on a contact sheet in full color, 4 pics per page. Save your jpegs.
3. **Capture a SERIES (20 or more) of similar or themed objects that cast extreme shadows.** Print on contact sheet in black and white, 4 pics per page. Save your jpegs.
4. **Capture a SERIES (20 or more) of summer flowers from different points of view** (worms eye, birds eye, eye level). Print on a contact sheet in full color, 4 pics per page. Save your Jpegs.

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2D Design : Summer Assignments

- **PORTRAIT:** Create a portrait or self-portrait a complementary, analogous, or split-complementary color scheme. You may use black and white as well as shades and tints of the chosen hues. Any medium that works. Size 11 x 14 to 18 x 24
 - **PERSPECTIVE:** Create a drawing of an unusual interior for instance, looking inside a cabinet, a drawer, refrigerator, purse, backpack, inside your car... use your imagination! **Only use black outline**, remember to use thick, thin, and medium lines. You may accent/add emphasis with one color. Use this color sparsely... do not put it everywhere on your drawing. Any medium that works. Size 11 x 14 to 18 x 24
 - **DESIGN/MOVEMENT:** Create an imaginative flowing design using only black and white lines. It needs to show depth/space and movement. Any medium that works, black and white. Size 11 x 14 to 18 x 24
 - **PATTERN:** Draw one object in contour line only. Using this object, create different sizes of it; small, medium, large, fat, short, thin, etc. Repeat these objects throughout your composition rotate them, do not overlap them. Create unity and balance, rotation. To create a focal point, you will use one color to one of the objects, using the rule of thirds. This object can be different than all of the other ones that repeating in the composition. For example, multiple different cats outlined in red ink, with one green dog for the focal point....multiple flowers outlined in black and yellow bumble bee for the focal point. Any medium that works. Size 11 x 14 to 18 x 24
- **Binder/ Artist Journal :** Begin a collection of what inspires you. I call it the "Inspiration Resource Collection". You will need to collect postcards, flyers, cut outs from magazines, computer print outs, etc. Attach your collected pictures of artwork to pages (8 1/2 x 11/printer paper) and write what you like about the image next to it, you will need to complete 8 pages.

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
