The Arts:

This year Camp Wildcat will be offering an arts program the length of the summer. Campers will have the opportunity to attend music, art, and library, and cooking classes for four weeks, taught by certified teachers.

On **Wednesday, July 25th** we will host a Parent Night in Marian Hall, when parents and friends are welcomed to join us to see the artwork we have created throughout the summer. We will serve light refreshments.

Field Trips:

Preschoolers and Rising Kindergarteners will attend two off-campus field trips, a trip to the Memphis Zoo, and Malco Theatres to see "Incredibles 2." ICCS staff will provide transportation to and from the field trip locations. Additionally, Camp Wildcat will have 10 on-campus activities throughout the summer. We will have water activities every Wednesday with Water Slides two of out of the seven water activities days. The dates listed on the calendar have been booked and are reserved for Camp Wildcat.

Route 40-Fun:

This year, we have an all-encompassing theme — Route 40-Fun. Each week will take us to another city on our cross-country trip, and we'll learn the history and cultures of some of America's most famous cities. Get ready to cruise down Route 40-Fun this summer, and don't forget your camera, as we make pit stops in all our favorite towns! We'll have a blast strolling down 5th avenue in the Big Apple, Walkin' in Memphis, Parading down the French Quarter in the Crescent city, Line Dancin' at the Texas rodeo, Skiing down the Rockies in Colorado, Surfin' USA in California, and exploring everywhere in between.

Nap:

Nap will be offered for two hours each day. Children who do not want to sleep may read a book on their mats for the first hour. After the first hour, campers may choose to color, read, or put together a puzzle in a separate area. Those who do sleep for the entire naptime will be awakened after two hours. Mats will be provided.

Pricing:

The total cost per week is **\$225**. A week is considered to be four to five camp days.

Drop-In With On- or Off-Campus Activity: **\$65**

Drop-In Without Outside Activity: **\$50**

If you pay for the entire summer in full by June 1st, the discounted price is **\$1,750.00** for the entire summer. This discount only applies to a full week of camp and cannot be used for drop-in days.

Three Children: **\$550** weekly total

Four Children: **\$680** weekly total
