Crew Assignments and Name Tag: If you enrolled early enough, you will have received a Day One Nametag with your child's crew assignment on it. If you didn't, you may pick up the nametag at registration on Day One. Put the tag on your child's front left shoulder so it can be clearly seen by the guides.

Drop Off: We would like for you to follow the signs and drive on Leonard St. which is on the west side of the church and pull up to the STOP sign at Leonard and Franklin Sts. (See attached diagram)! Guides will be there to help your child from the car and escort each child down the sidewalk and up the front steps and into the sanctuary. Your child's leaders will be waiting in the pew for the children each morning. If you wish to come into the church with your child, you are welcome to park in the north parking lot at the corner of Lightburne St. and Franklin and use the cross walk to the church building entrance. Guides will welcome you there and help your child find his group/class.

Pick Up: For safety reasons, parents will be responsible for picking up all children. They will be in the sanctuary at 12:00 p.m. each day. Children will not be allowed to exit the building without a parent or pre-approved adult escort. Parents, please see your child's leader on the first day if there are special instructions or issues. The leaders will have a list of names at the pew and will need to check off your child's name when you come to pick him/her up. The sanctuary entrance (Franklin St) and the south doors (Kansas St.) will be open at the end of the morning for pick-up. The sanctuary doors will be locked from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. If you need to pick up your child during these times, we ask you to enter the south/ Kansas St. entrance and check in at the Welcome Desk. The church parking lot at Lightburne and Franklin Sts. is available each day but Friday.

Daily Offering: Your child will have the opportunity to help others in two ways this week at VBS. We are asking the children to bring a monetary gift each day that will be collected and given directly towards the Upland Holistic Development Project in Thailand. Second Baptist has a partnership with UHDP and is involved with their work in rural development among the hill-tribe people there. Our money will specifically go towards the water projects. As UHDP starts a new relationship with a village, the first project is often a clean water source like a water well and delivery system. Our kiddos can feel good knowing they are making a difference in the lives of these marginalized friends. (Parents, we encourage you to use this opportunity to have a conversation with your child about the discipleship of giving, whether it be 5¢ each day or \$5.00. What we want is for your child to experience the joy of helping someone else, and as you enjoy the benefits of clean water, it's a perfect opportunity to talk.

The other opportunity for giving will be through bringing school supplies for the local In As Much Ministry. As school begins, In As Much provides necessary new supplies for those families in the Liberty area who aren't able to buy them on their own. Below is a list of what we are asking you to bring each day:

- Monday: notebook paper or spiral notebooks – college or wide rule
- Tuesday: 24 count crayons or colored pencils
- Wednesday: pocket folders with brads, all colors
- Thursday: pencil boxes or pencil pouches
- Friday: pencils or ink pens (red, black, blue ink)

Friday evening celebration: Mark your calendars to join us back in the Sanctuary on Friday evening, the 13th at 7:00 for a short presentation of music and pictures from the week. We will end our time together with a fun fellowship in the parking lot.

Celebration Sunday: We also invite you and your family to be at the 11:00 worship service on Sunday, July 15. Your VBS children will be singing songs from the week at the beginning of the service, so please arrive by 10:50 so we can gather in the Assembly Room, located behind the sanctuary. After worship, the whole congregation is invited to have their Sunday dinner on the south side of the church with food trucks! The trucks coming are Casual Foodie, and Humdinger, (both with typical food truck fare) and Frosty Treats Ice Cream truck. Hope you will plan to be with us to celebrate the end of a wild ride experiencing God's love for us!
