

The Winegardner Auditorium is a banquet room located within the main museum building, featuring the Adler Pewter Collection and a selection of paintings from the Dixon's Permanent Collection. It includes a permanent wood stage with projector screen, projector, and podium with microphone, as well as a catering kitchen and restroom facilities; gallery access is included with rental (availability varies). Rental covers use of the Winegardner Auditorium only; any event setup in areas outside of the Auditorium must be approved in advance by the Dixon. This venue is available for corporate and non-profit rental, as well as select private events; this space is not available for wedding events.

CAPACITY

- 250 standing reception
- 200 seated, theater-style
- 75 seated, classroom-style
- 120-150 seated, round tables (15, 60" round tables with 8-10 chairs each, leaving the stage free of tables)

Capacity can vary depending on your setup needs; all numbers are approximate.
