This year, there was a 27% increase in countries visited. We have expanded our reach in 2016.

PEOPLE SERVING ON HOPE TRIPS

134 on 14 trips

This year, there was a 24% increase in trip goers over 2015. Your donations toward the Participation Funding allowed GO to give away \$46,230.40 in order to make these trips more affordable.

Of those 134 people, 10 will become long-term, mission interns in 2017 and 1 now serving on our partners non-profit board. These trip goers have sponsored kids, funded projects, discipled 100s and continue to pray for those they met while on these short-term missions. Global Outreach has been a stepping stone for them to continue their call to GO. Matt. 28:19

MORE THAN \$56,000 WENT TOWARD PROJECTS COMPLETED IN-FIELD BY OUR TEAMS & PARTNERS

Mexico - Men's Ministry continued a church construction project.

Belize - In conjunction with Hope's Dinner on Demand Program, we funded solar panels for Hopewell Children's Home. They power 100% of the main living quarters.

We completed construction on their new house parent's home and built a feed house on property. Funded and repaired roof in the community, among many other projects.

Kenya - Completed a community outreach art project in partnership with Uweza Foundation (Kibera Slums) at Watu Wa Maana Orphanage. Also at Watu, in conjunction with Hope's Dinner on Demand Program, we raised enough money to provide 2 more shipping containers for store front income.

Haiti - Goats for Hope project brought in \$5680 to buy more than 18 goats for our partners at a Place of Hope. Repaired play set for kids of the orphanage, among other projects..

Uganda - Funded goat pen project at the James Place, Heal Ministries. Clean Water for Hope project raised \$7500 to bring clean water to our partners in Jinja.

KIDS REACHED THROUGH VBS

Vacation Bible School was held across 5 different countries in 9 programs. Our team members prepared months before each trip. Because of our teams, 959 children heard the Gospel and felt Christ's love.

In addition to our VBS trips, we had 3 that were centered around discipleship programming. The **Women's Germany** team led a high school girl's retreat and a women's conference.

The **Uganda** team discipled young boys, abandoned women, moms and more. The **Special Kids Kenya** team led the community of Kibera in awareness and education workshops to better equip them in working with children with disabilities.
