

## 13<sup>th</sup> Street and C.L. Werner Parkway

**Completion:** 2012

The same intersection that visitors have used to enter Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium for decades, 13<sup>th</sup> Street and Bert Murphy Avenue, was transformed into a softly curved, tree-lined boulevard and given a new namesake.

Now 13<sup>th</sup> Street and C.L. Werner Parkway, the redesigned access road leads Zoo visitors from 13<sup>th</sup> Street to several parking lots categorized by birds, mammals, reptiles and a 13<sup>th</sup> Street zone.

A separate drive south of the main boulevard also gives visitors and, more importantly, school buses access to a dedicated drop-off zone, located west of the Zoo's main entrance.

13<sup>th</sup> Street and C.L. Werner Parkway was part of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium's Gateway to the Wild Capital Campaign, a \$33 million project geared toward enhancing the visitor's experience. The campaign, Phase I of the Zoo's Master Plan, included the addition and improvement of guest amenities from 13<sup>th</sup> Street to the Zoo's main entrance down to the renovation of the Suzanne and Walter Scott Aquarium.
