The First National Bank Entrance Plaza included more than 14,000 square feet of construction at the time ground was broken on the project.

The plaza involved the replacement of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium's existing main gift shop, as well as its guest services, gates and ticketing areas.



First National Bank Plaza was part of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium's Gateway to the Wild Capital Campaign, a \$33 million project geared toward enhancing the visitor's experience. The campaign, Phase I of the Zoo's Master Plan, included the addition and improvement of guest amenities from 13th Street to the Zoo's main entrance down to the renovation of the Suzanne and Walter Scott Aquarium.
