

Omaha Steaks Grill and Patio

Omaha Steaks Grill and Patio, adjacent to the Lied Jungle®, features 6,200 square foot of space and provides seating for 240 visitors.

A new sound system projects music for visitors to enjoy as they savor world-renowned Omaha Steaks menu items.



This project was completed in tandem with Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium's Entry Plaza to Main Street, a pedestrian-friendly boulevard that enhanced the Zoo's most beloved sculpture, Lion's Pride, with a larger soft-surface base, vibrant landscaping and a continuous semicircular limestone bench.

Omaha Steaks Grill and Patio was part of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium's Gateway to the Wild Capital Campaign, a \$33 million project geared toward enhancing the visitor's experience. The campaign, Phase I of the Zoo's Master Plan, included the addition and improvement of guest amenities from 13th Street to the Zoo's main entrance down to the renovation of the Suzanne and Walter Scott Aquarium.
