General Information

To become a member of Photo Club you must:

- Have an Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium membership for the current year
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Pay \$20.00 annual Photo Club registration fee. Annual fee is good from June 1 through the following May 31.
- Complete the registration form which can be found at www.omahazoo.com, the Kids/Family Tab followed by the Clubs tab.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **When does Photo Club meet?** Photo Club meets the first Saturday of every month at 9 a.m. in Mutual of Omaha's Wild Kingdom Pavilion Auditorium.
- **When is the annual Photo Club Fee Due?** The annual fee is due by June 1 of the current year. To be a member of Photo Club, you must be a member of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium. Zoo memberships are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- **What is the annual fee used for?** The annual fee is used to cover general office expenses (i.e. registration forms and badges, etc.). It is also used to cover the use of Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's meeting space for monthly meetings and guest speakers.
- **Can I post my photos taken at the Zoo as a member of Photo Club on social media sites like Facebook?** As long as the photos are taken from a public path, you can post the pictures. The only photos not allowed are ones that are behind-the-scenes, which as a Photo Club member you will not have access to.
- **Will photos I take be used by the Zoo?** Any photo you provide to Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium becomes the property of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium. It can be used on our website, advertising (brochures, billboards, etc.), bi-monthly ENEWS, ZooPrints, social media, on grounds, special events and other places where appropriate.
- **What rights do I have to the photos I take at Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium?** You have all the rights to your photos to what you choose with them. Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's has the right to use the photo where they see fit. Photos taken at the Zoo should not be credited to the Zoo.
- **Will I receive photo credit when my photos are used by Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium?** Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's does not provide photo credit for any photo used. If requested, a copy of where the photo was used can be provided for your records by emailing communications@omahazoo.com.
- **How do I give my photos to Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium?** Please provide hi-resolution photos (300 dpi) on a CD labeled with your name, date and phone number where you can be reached. The photos can be dropped off at Guest Services, located at the Main Gate, Attention: Marketing. No photos received via email will be accepted.
- **When can I come in early as a benefit to Photo Club?** Early access to Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's is on Friday mornings year-round, 30 minutes before the Zoo opens. Photo Club entry is: March 9 through November 1: 8:30 a.m. and November 2 through March 7: 9:30 a.m. You must bring your Photo Club badge, photo ID and Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's membership card on each visit. Please note that exhibits will be open on a limited basis.
- **Where can I find info about Photo Club?** Visit www.omahazoo.com, click on the Kids/Family Tab followed by the Clubs tab.
- **Where can I go while at the Zoo?** Photos can be taken anywhere at the Zoo as long as they are from a public path and not in a restricted/behind-the-scenes area. Please refer to the Zoo map for public paths.
- **How late can I stay at the Zoo?** March 9 through November 1, the Zoo is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., buildings stay open until 6 p.m. November 2 through March 7, the Zoo is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., buildings stay open until 5 p.m.
- **I want to hold a photo shoot at the Zoo. Can I do this?** Please refer to Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium's Photo-Video Policy.
