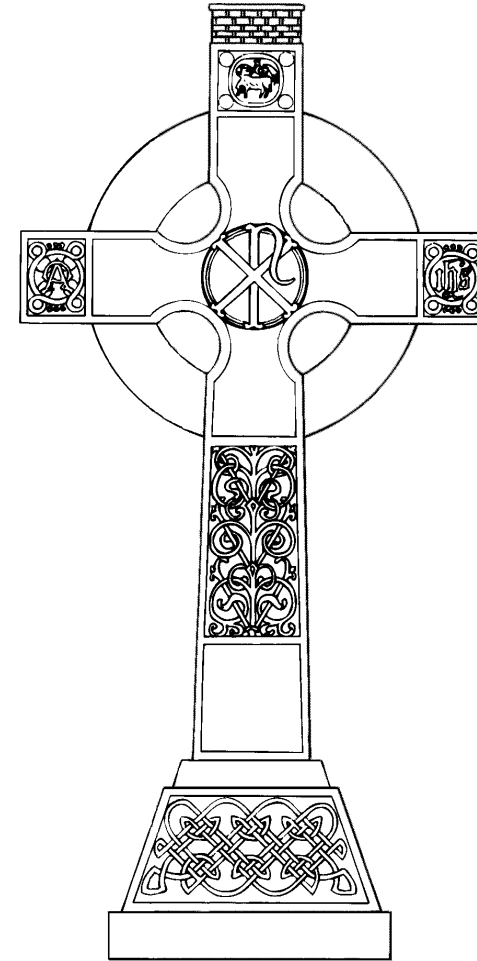

JANE DEPARTED OUR PRESENCE ON FEBRUARY 8, 2013, FOLLOWING AN ARDUOUS BATTLE WITH PARKINSON'S DISEASE. TO THE END, JANE WAS LOVING, KIND AND CARING TO ALL WHO CROSSED HER PATH. SHE WAS A WONDERFUL WIFE AND MOTHER, A FUN LOVING PARTICIPANT IN LIFE, AND A GOOD FRIEND. JANE WAS BORN IN DALLAS ON APRIL 23, 1946, TO SARAH AND HAROLD COOPER. SHE ATTENDED PRESTON HOLLOW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN DALLAS, THEN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN TYLER, TX. FOLLOWING GRADUATION FROM TYLER HIGH SCHOOL IN 1962, JANE ENTERED THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS IN AUSTIN WHERE SHE MET THE LOVE OF HER LIFE. JANE AND JOHN WERE MARRIED

IN OCTOBER 1966. JANE IS SURVIVED BY JOHN DOE, HER HUSBAND OF 47 YEARS, SON MICHAEL AND HIS WIFE MARY OF DALLAS, AND SON JAMES AND HIS WIFE AMY OF HOUSTON, AND GRANDCHILDREN ANNIE, CHARLOTTE, WILLIAM, COOPER AND AVA. JANE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER PARENTS SARAH AND HAROLD COOPER, BROTHERS JUSTIN AND JONATHAN AND AUNT AMELIA STOCKTON. THROUGHOUT HER LIFE JANE WAS AN AVID GARDENER AND WAS A MEMBER OF THE GARDENEERS GARDEN CLUB OF DALLAS. WHILE RAISING HER CHILDREN, SHE SERVED AS A PTA OFFICER, ROOM MOTHER, AND DEVOTED SOCCER MOM. WEEKLY CAFETERIA DUTY AT BRADFIELD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL WAS ONE OF HER FAVORITE ACTIVITIES. JANE WAS A VOLUNTEER AT CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF DALLAS. JANE WAS A PASSIONATE SUPPORTER OF HER SONS' ATHLETIC ENDEAVORS. SHE ALSO ENJOYED TENNIS, GOLF AND BRIDGE. MANY OF HER FONDEST MEMORIES INVOLVED GIRLS' TRIPS TO CABO SAN LUCAS WITH HER TENNIS TEAM, WEEKLY GAMES WITH THE BIG GIRLS BRIDGE CLUB AND HER NEIGHBORHOOD WINE CLUB. SHE ALSO LOVED TO TRAVEL, OFTEN ACCOMPANYING JOHN ON BUSINESS TRIPS TO HONG KONG AND PARIS, AND BIKING THROUGH THE FRENCH AND ITALIAN COUNTRYSIDES. RELIGIOUS FAITH WAS IMPORTANT IN JANE'S LIFE, NURTURED EARLY AT PRESTON HOLLOW BAPTIST CHURCH IN DALLAS AND THIRD BAPTIST CHURCH IN LONGVIEW. JANE WAS ACTIVE IN SUNDAY SCHOOL, BIBLE STUDIES, PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN, NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION AND YOUTH EDUCATION. SHE SERVED AS A DEACON AT HIGHLAND PARK PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH. IN 1984, JANE JOINED EBBY HALLIDAY REALTORS AND EMBARKED UPON A VERY SUCCESSFUL RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE CAREER OF 14 YEARS. HER LOVE OF HOMES, KEEN INTERPERSONAL SKILLS AND STRONG DESIRE TO SERVE HER CLIENTS MADE HER ONE OF THE TOP AGENTS OF HER ERA. DURING HER CAREER SHE GARNERED NUMEROUS AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS AND ROSE TO THE OFFICE OF SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT OF THE FIRM. THE FAMILY IS DEEPLY INDEBTED TO THE STAFF OF THE MEMORY CARE UNIT OF ABC ASSISTED LIVING COMMUNITY FOR THE WONDERFUL CARE THEY PROVIDED JANE DURING HER FINAL YEAR.
