3. Sara has also mentioned that it would be nice to have a few picnic tables on our Fellowship Hall porches for both children and adults to enjoy.

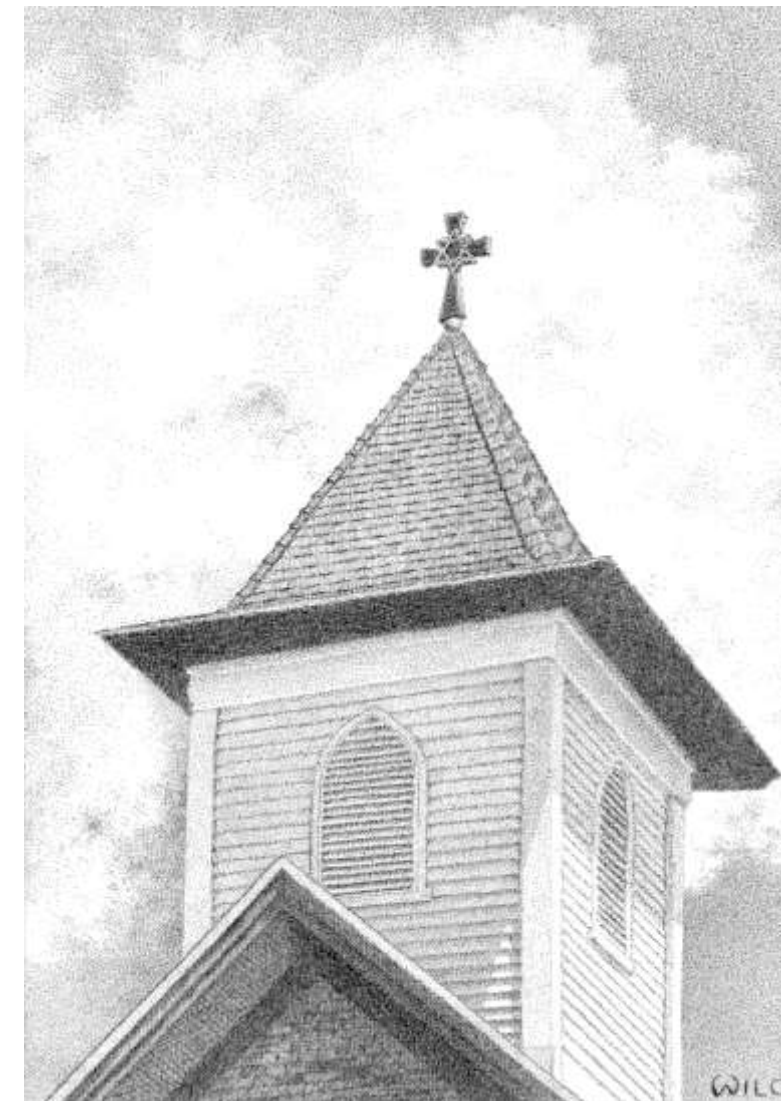
