### Art Award

Christian Brothers University is proud to offer Awards by competition at the Brooks Museum League's Mid-South Scholastic Art Awards. The Visual Art Award will be presented to students demonstrating outstanding academic success and artistic ability. Eligibility will be based upon a review of the student's portfolio and ability to meet the admission requirements for CBU. Two \$3000.00 Visual Arts awards will be given to students interested in majoring in one of the following areas: Studio Art, Art Therapy, or Graphic Design. Each will be awarded in two installments divided equally between fall and spring semester. This award may be continued each year based on the student's academic and creative performance. **Awards may be combined with other scholarships or Financial Aid given by CBU.**

### Requirements for Eligibility

- Incoming, full-time freshman.
- Students listing Christian Brothers University as one of their top schools.
- Declare a *Major* in Visual Art (with concentrations in studio arts, art therapy, or graphic design) upon admission to CBU.
- Student must enroll in at least 6 credit hours of art per semester.
- SAT or ACT scores satisfying the admission requirements of Christian Brothers University.
- Complete forms and submit portfolio to the Brooks Museum League's Mid-South Scholastic Art Awards.
