[Art Merit Scholarship Requirements]

- Offered to an outstanding student with demonstrated artistic ability and academic success
- Must be a first time incoming freshman, no transfer students
- Recipient must enroll as a full-time student at The University of Mississippi and must complete at least two art courses each semester
- Scholarship will continue for four years (eight consecutive semesters; no summer school) and recipient must maintain a 3.0 grade point average with no less than 12 credit hours per semester

[Scholarship Information]

- The scholarship of \$500 will be awarded in two equal payments (\$250 in the fall and \$250 in the spring), as well as \$2,000 (\$1,000 per semester) toward non-resident fees for out-of-state students.
- To apply, the applicant must submit the Scholastic Art Awards Entry forms and portfolio. Please follow the instructions provided with the entry forms obtained from the Memphis Brooks Museum of Art.

[What can we offer?]

The Department of Art at the University of Mississippi has over 260 undergraduate majors in art history and studio art.
