



Student Behavior Guidelines for Field Trips

Soon you will be up close to some of planet's rarest and most powerful creatures. For their well-being and everyone's safety, please review these guidelines with students.

- Stay with your assigned adult. Your adult will have a map and schedule to help find and see everything.
- Take your time and walk through the Zoo. Running is not permitted.
- Remain in your seat or standing still when participating in Zoo shows and activities.
- Be respectful of the animals – you are visiting their home.
- Stay on the visitor paths and keep your hands to yourselves. All animals can be dangerous.
- Leave the plants, flowers and trees alone.
- Keep your voices down so the animals don't get startled.
- Read the signs to learn about the animals.
- Also ask Zoo staff any questions at the end of any activity.
- Have fun!

The teachers and chaperones will review read their sheet and review the above guidelines with their students prior to zoo entry and we will all abide by them. My group will be responsible for any and all damage caused by its members.
