

Student Organization Point System

The Bethel University Organization Point system is to ensure that official student organizations (1) are held accountable to remain active on campus, (2) stay involved in the Bethel campus and McKenzie Community, and (3) are given opportunities to develop leadership skills and grow their organization.

Organizations are required to accumulate 150 points each semester to remain a student organization on campus. Therefore, all activity records must be turned in on or before the last day of the month that school is in session. Activities completed in December or May are ineligible for recognition as those months usually only include finals week.

***** The per person points will apply to the organization requirement points, but not apply to the organization of the year points system due to the varying amounts of members in organizations.**

Descriptions

Attendance at SGA Meetings: These points will be awarded automatically after attendance at SGA meetings are confirmed by the Senate Roll Call Sheet held by the SGA Secretary of Affairs. Each organization shall have one person appointed to attend these meetings according to the SGA Constitution

Providing at least one club report at an SGA meeting: This report is optional. However, each student organization can earn points by preparing and giving a short update about the organization to the

Senate. This is a good way to inform other organization leaders about the purpose of your organization. These points will be awarded automatically by the student activities director.

Participation of one organization member in the SGA Homecoming Committee *required by SGA Constitution*: This is a requirement by the SGA constitution, however, participation in this committee will earn the organization points for each meeting attended. These points will be awarded automatically by the chairmen of the Homecoming Committee.

Attendance at Chapel: One point per person for each chapel service. **Sign-In Sheet Present**

Attendance at Sport, Music, Art, or Theatrical Event: These points will be given for each member that attends these events. In order to obtain the points, members of your organization need to be in attendance for the full length of the event. The members must be audience members and not participants in the game or performance. You must take a photo at the event with the members for proof of your attendance. This will be reported on the monthly activities record. **Sign-In Sheet Present**

Participation in Prevention Services Events: Throughout the school year the Director of Prevention Services holds different events and/or awareness activities. In the past, this has included things like Suicide Prevention Awareness Week and Sexual Assault Awareness. If your organization participates with these events, you will be eligible for these points. The Director of Prevention Services will set the terms and conditions on an event by event basis. The director will be charged with communication with the Student Activities Director when these points should be awarded. This will be reported on the monthly activities record. **Signature Required. Sign-In Sheet Present**

Participation in Campus Wide Activities: These points are awarded and given to organizations who participate in campus wide events for recruitment and school involvement such as Organization Fairs, Freshman Orientation Fair, Boo Bash, Tailgating at Homecoming, Purple and Gold, or any other events designated by the Student Activities Director. It is imperative at these events that the majority of your club participates. This will be reported on the monthly activity record. **Sign-In Sheet Present**

Fundraising Activity for Organization: These points will be awarded to an organization for activities designed to raise money for their own organization. This will be reported on the monthly activity record.

Volunteering For 3 Hours With Local Charity: These points can be obtained by at least 50% or 10 actual members of an organization volunteering their time at a local charity such as the Carroll County Humane Society, Carroll County United Neighbors, Local Church, City of McKenzie, etc. If the organization would like to volunteer with an organization outside of the Carroll County Area, please approve it with the Student Activities Director. The 3 hours can accumulate over the time frame of one semester. For example, if your organization volunteers at the Humane Society for 2 hours in February and 1 hour in April the full points would be awarded to your organization. However, if you do not complete 3 hours, no points will be awarded. This will be reported on the monthly activity record. **Signature Required.**

Planning and Implementing a Campus Wide Activity with Student Activities Director: If your organization partners with Student Activities to help plan and implement an event, these points would be awarded to your organization. This will be reported on the monthly activity record.

Raising at least \$200 for a Charitable Organization: If your organization raises \$200 or more for an organization like the American Heart Association, American Cancer Association, Children's Miracle Network Hospitals, or any local charity these points will be awarded to your organization. For each \$200 raised, these points will be awarded again. The Student Activities Director will have to maintain proof that this amount has been donated before the points are awarded. This will be reported on the monthly activity report. **Signature Required from Supervisor or Organization Administration.**
