Rules of the Show: Ready Made Arts and Crafts vendors are required to showcase art that demonstrates a relationship with nature, informs about nature and its processes, educates about environmental problems, and/or utilizes reclaimed, recycled, or natural materials, and above all honors nature in aesthetic ways. Set-up and Breakdown Hours: Set-up is from 12-4pm on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> (overnight security will be provided) and 6:30 AM until 9:30 AM on Saturday, April 27 - NO EXCEPTIONS! Tear down is after 5 PM until 7 PM post-festival on Saturday, April 27, 2019. In the event of windy weather, we will not set-up on the 5<sup>th</sup>. Please ensure that you leave your space clean and all garbage is removed from your area. In the event the celebration is in progress and weather becomes an issue, you may pack up, cover or secure your booth; however, you will not be allowed to bring your car onto the grounds or leave until all patrons have left the area and the parking supervisor has cleared the area for vehicles.
