

2018-19 Memory Verses

GREEN STAR RECOGNITION/ INCENTIVES:

- Each child will be “rewarded” at the end of the season for scripture memory. They will share their verses for memory with their coach during the week of February 4. Coaches will submit the names of children and how many verses they memorized. The “rewards” will be based on the following tiers:

- Minimum requirement for all ages to memorize are the 7 verses in BOLD*.
- Bonus incentive for anyone that memorizes all 12 verses.
- All verses listed are in the NIRV translation.

1. Psalm 119:9: How can a young person keep his life pure? By living in keeping with your word.
2. Psalm 119:10: I trust in you with all my heart. Don't let me wander away from your commands.
3. Psalm 119:11: I have hidden your word in my heart so that I won't sin against you.
4. **Romans 12:10: Love one another deeply. Honor others more than yourselves.**
5. Philippians 2:3: Don't do anything only to get ahead. Don't do it because you are proud. Instead, be free of pride. Think of others as better than yourselves.
6. Philippians 2:4: None of you should look out just for your own good. You should also look out for the good of others.
7. 1 Peter 2:17: Show proper respect to everyone. Love the community of believers. Have respect for God. Honor the king.
8. **Exodus 20:12: Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long time in the land the LORD your God is giving you.**
9. John 13:34: I give you a new command. Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.
10. **James 1:12a: Blessed is the man who keeps on going when times are hard.**
11. **Galatians 6:9: Let us not become tired of doing good. At the right time we will gather a crop if we don't give up**
12. Luke 1:37: Nothing is impossible with God.
13. **Hebrews 11:1: Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being certain of what we do not see.**
14. Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and tender to one another. Forgive each other, just as God forgave you because of what Christ has done.
15. **John 3:16: For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.**
16. **John 3:17: God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world. He sent his Son to save the world through him.**
