Youth Fishing Rodeo Rules and Regulations

- Parents may assist the contestants with baiting hooks and landing fish. However, contestants must maintain primary control of the fishing rig.
- Only one fishing rig (Rod and Reel, Cane Pole, etc.) per contestant.
- Contestants must fish from the bank (Entering the water for any reason is strictly prohibited).
- All fish will be weighed. Total weight will determine 1st through 3rd place winners in each age bracket. (Age brackets are 6 and under, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, and Adults Special Needs.)
- Nets may be used to land fish only. **All fish must be weighed on a rope stringer.**
- Participants must provide their own tackle and bait. (Worms and crickets are accepted. No live fish.)
- Participants may use only one hook.
- All decisions of tournament officials are final.
- The Fishing Rodeo will be held rain or shine and will only be delayed in case of lightning.
- Registration forms and the \$15 contribution to The Baddour Center are due at registration for the Fishing Rodeo.
- All participants must have a signed parent and/or guardian consent and release from liability form to participate.
