

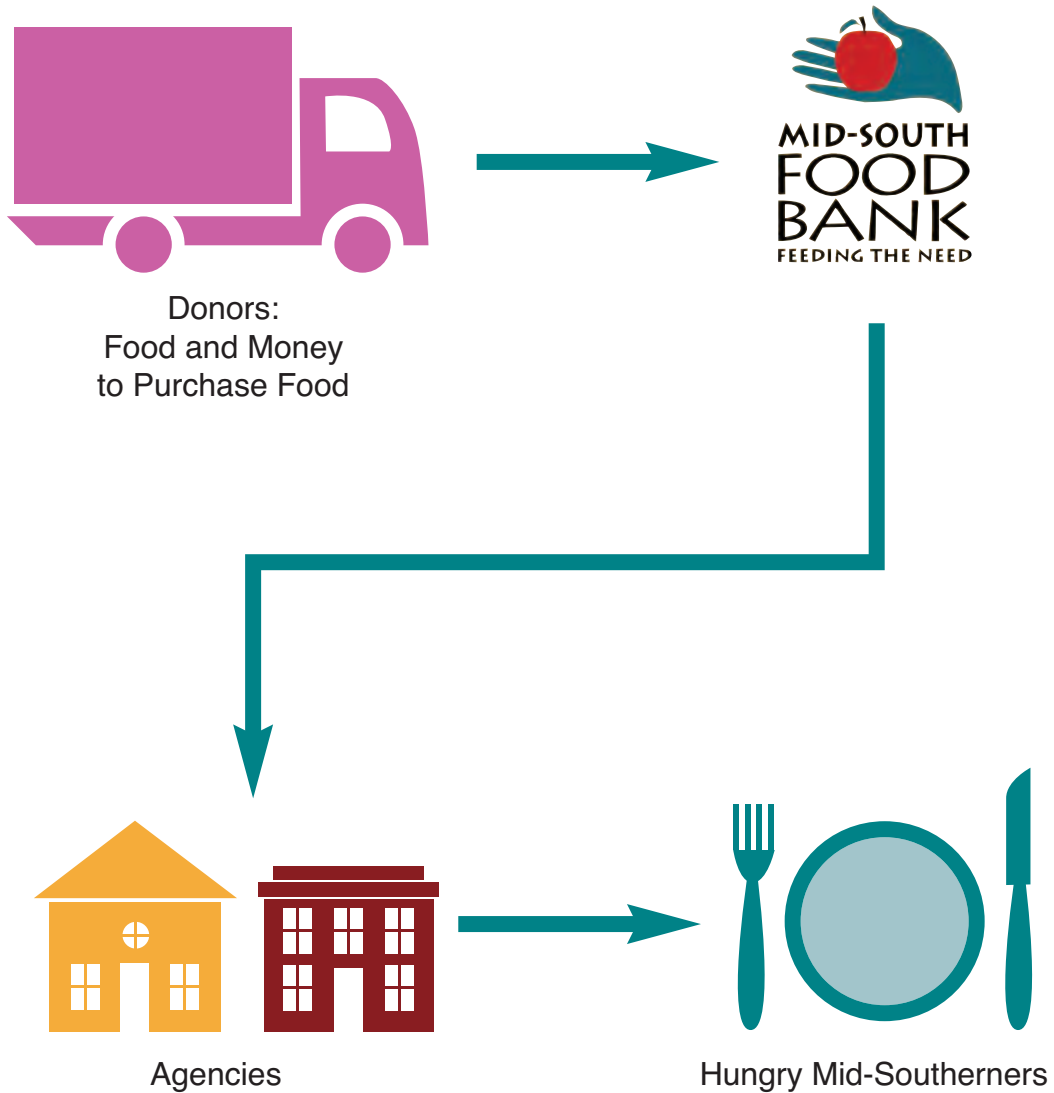

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT & CEO AND THE 2016-2017 CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

Thank you for making FY2016-2017 another remarkable year for Mid-South Food Bank! This year marked 36 years of service for the organization. Our dedicated team has done a great job at expanding our outreach while strengthening our programs and services to provide nutritious food for our neighbors in need. Our total distribution last year was 12 million pounds of food, or the equivalent of 10 million meals for hungry children, families and seniors.

A few program highlights include:

- Food for Kids BackPack Boxes provided 62,961 meals for more than 2,000 children. Kids Cafes served 5,049 to an average of 350 children.
- The new Summer Harvest Family program provided food for 175 families at four locations.
- After the devastating storm in Memphis, four Mobile Pantry disaster relief distributions provided 110,000 pounds of food to more than 1,800 households.
- Seniors received more than 6,000 Senior Grocery Boxes through our partner agencies. In collaboration with MIFA, the Aging Commission, Baptist and Methodist Hospitals and other partners, the No Hungry Senior program provided boxes of shelf-stable food for nearly 3,000 vulnerable seniors in their homes.



Nancy and Daniel Verela moved to DeSoto County, Mississippi about two years ago. Originally from Mexico, the couple visits the Interfaith Food Pantry in Hernando periodically to help feed their family of five. Daniel is employed as a sheetrock worker, but his working hours are varied and seasonal. Sometimes he works 40 hours a week, but not every week. Because of his work schedule, the couple only visit the pantry when their supply of food at home diminishes – every two to three months.

Translating Spanish to English can be difficult, but signing up at the pantry and receiving the extra food is “simple and easy,” according to Nancy. “My friends, my neighbors, told me about the pantry. Everything is great about it. The milk, the bread, the vegetables. We are so grateful,” she said.

The Verelas visited the pantry with their three-year-old daughter, Allison, while her two brothers, Daniel, 13, and Ulysses, 8 were in school. “People are very kind here. The food assistance helps us in so many ways,” Nancy added.





A special group of volunteers arrived at Mid-South Food Bank last year. Known as the IP Spouses, they are the spouses of executives at International Paper. Their specialty at the Food Bank is packing boxes for the Senior Grocery Program, No Hungry Senior Program or the Food for Kids BackPack Program. There are about 100 people on the register, with groups of eight to 12 working at the Food Bank warehouse every month.

When asked why they enjoy the work, the group members talked about the satisfaction they get from the work; knowing they are helping to feed hungry seniors or children. They said they can imagine a senior receiving the box of food and what a relief that must be to know they will have something healthy to eat. They also shared that they have fun doing it together, meeting others from International Paper, and seeing the company's commitment to the community in action. The boxes they pack are all donated to Mid-South Food Bank by International Paper.

International Paper uses their people, products and resources to address critical community needs. The IP Spouses are a perfect example of community involvement. They put their best into every project.





Three years ago, Swift Transportation empowered its local offices to choose community charities to support. In Memphis, employees decided to help fight hunger with Mid-South Food Bank. The company has been critically helpful in multiple ways.

While its employees have held internal and external donation drives, Swift regularly re-routes trailers carrying excess non-designated food supplies to Mid-South Food Bank, totaling more than 36,000 pounds in the last three years. The company also donated a Swift trailer, increasing Mid-South Food Bank's distribution capacity while saving the Food Bank more than \$20,000 in key operational costs.

"We all have really big hearts at Swift and want to help others in any way that we can, and we try to make all of our charitable events as fun as possible," said Lara Buckingham, Swift Linehaul Fleet Leader and a Swift charity ambassador.

Buckingham said helping to fight hunger came from Swift's first food drive, held at Walmart when its new charitable mission was connected to real people: "Several people throughout that day came to us and asked if we could give them food. Then we learned about how much hunger affects children during the summer. Both those things broke my heart and helped make us an advocate for the Food Bank and what it does," she said.

Swift has garnered multiple awards from employees' efforts in Operation Feed, Mid-South Food Bank's biggest donation drive held every summer. Their Op Feed awards hang proudly in the lobby, with room to add more in the future.

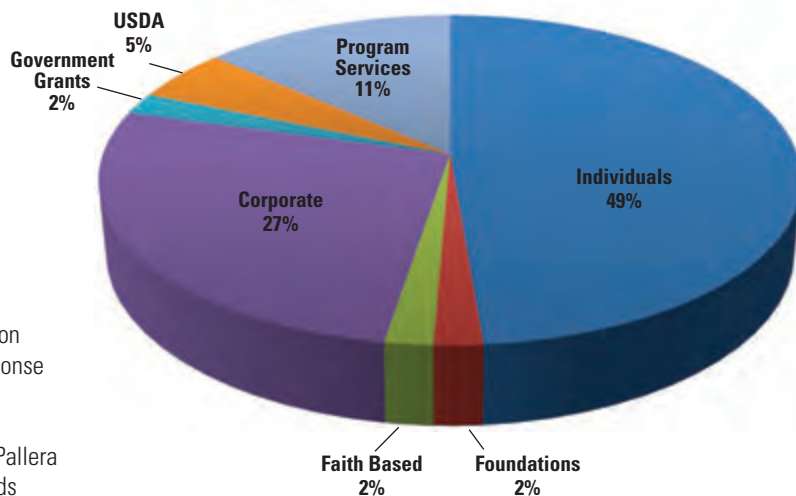

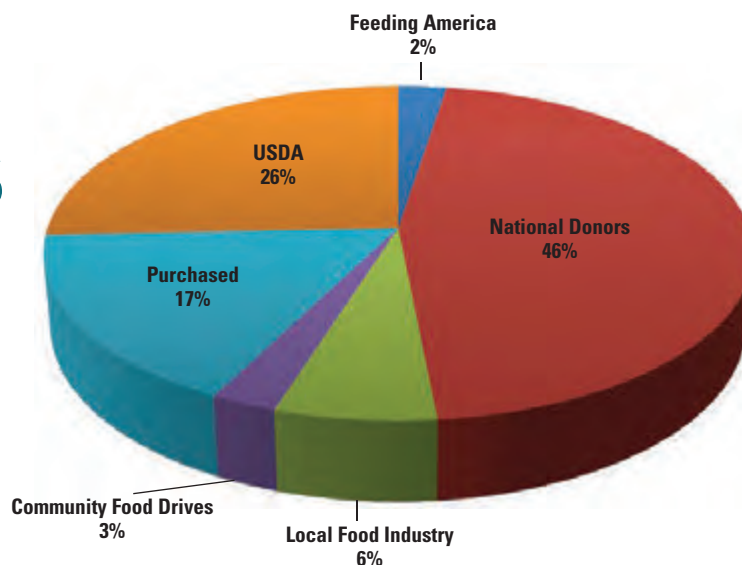

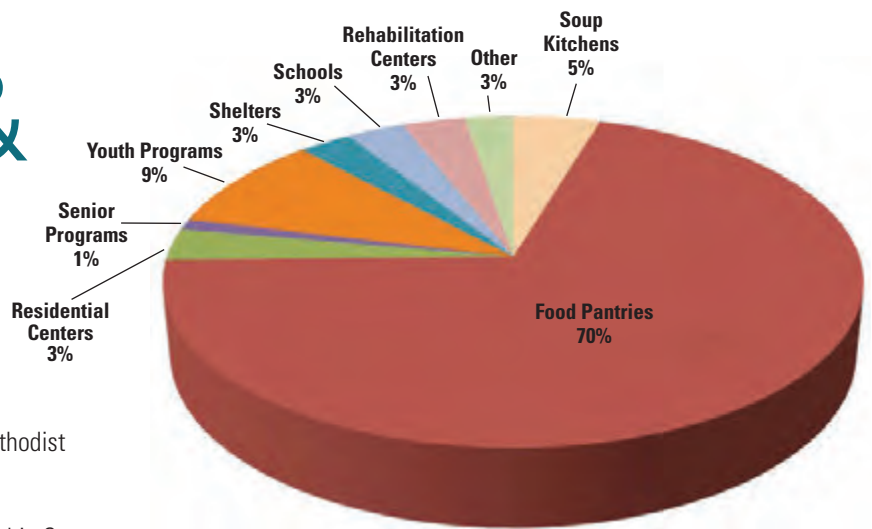
