Mission and Vision

Northside's mission is to connect unconnected people to Jesus Christ by connecting them to Christ, Community and their Calling.

We desire for the Student Ministry at Northside to be a vibrant, fun, and irresistible environment for our students; but above that we want it to be a place where their faith is challenged and grown. We want our students to *own* their faith and then *live* their faith out in the world.

Our vision for the Student Ministry Worship Minister is to not only lead worship in our student ministry environments, but to cultivate a thriving worship ministry. This team member will recruit and develop volunteers in both the musical and technical fields of worship arts, collaborate with the student ministry team on creative ideas and elements, be a present in the lives of our students both in the church and outside of its walls, and to be a point person in the production and execution of the weekly services/large events.

Responsibilities

Worship Leading

Lead authentic, energetic and engaging worship and programming for both Jr. High and High School services and special events. Oversee all musical aspects including song selection, creation of materials (sheets, charts, Ableton sessions, etc), training and scheduling of band and vocal volunteers, and onstage worship leading.

Worship Leading Expectations:

- Lead for the Rising (High School) 35 times a year
- Lead for Alive (Jr. High) at least 30 times a year
- Schedule, train and equip volunteer worship leaders for weekends off
- Co-lead for Nights of Worship/Special Weekends throughout the year on the main stage

Technical Creation and Execution

Oversee the set up and execution of technical elements for all programming (sound, lights, video). This includes developing and working through volunteers, setting up and programming of video (proresenter), patching, setting up and programming sound, and lighting. Candidates with graphic design and video editing experience will be highly considered.

Volunteer Development and Pastoring

Recruit, lead, train, grow, shepherd and care for volunteers and students within and outside of the church's walls.

Creative & Collaborative Brainstorming

Collaborate with the Student Ministries team to come up with creative elements and programming for all services.

Purpose

- Consistently evaluate the effectiveness of worship arts within student ministry.
- Create environments so compelling and exciting for students that it becomes the "most exciting hour" of their week
- Provide and execute a strategy for equipping and training new volunteers to allow them to fully use their gifts and talents for the Lord.
- Create, plan and execute services/events that will help student's faith be challenged and grow, all while doing it in a fun and creative way.
- Be more than just a figure on stage, but be a shepherd who is more than willing to be among the students and walk through life *with* them, not just addressing them in a microphone.
- Be a team player who is willing to collaborate with other ministers and ministries in the church.

- Knowledgeable about technical musicality and worship arts (i.e. Ableton, setting a stage, Allen & Heath soundboards and system.)
- Skills in graphic design (i.e. Photoshop, Adobe, etc.) and in videography/photography (NOT REQUIRED BUT HELPFUL)
- Willing to commit to 3-C Faithfulness
