MISSION AND VISION

Northside's mission is to connect unconnected people to Jesus Christ by connecting them to Christ, community and their calling.

Our vision for the Web Developer and IT Support role is to oversee key web technologies used by staff and Northside's ministries to effectively reach unconnected people and help them take their best next step.

Northside's ministries make use of a combination of a public web site and web-based Church Management System (ChMS) to communicate publicly, track metrics and evaluate ministry efforts.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Development: 60%

Evaluate feature releases for applicability to ministry needs. Extend functionality of the ChMS to grow ministry capability, as provided by the platform.

Maintenance: 20%

Maintain a relationship with vendors to ensure our outward facing web site is operating effectively. Regularly verify internal tools are being backed up and patched appropriately. Implement appropriate monitoring to be notified if external tools are having an impact on expected workflows. Assist the Director of IT as needed to maintain and improve general IT infrastructure.

Training: 20%

Communicate with staff to ensure that additional functionality is understandable and can be implemented within each ministry as appropriate. Provide general support to the staff.

- Incorporate feedback and ministry needs into the technology evaluation process
- Anticipate opportunities to improve systems and tools utilized by ministry
