WEEK OF OCTOBER 15-21, 2017

“Live up to your name!”

## DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Acts 11:19-30
-  **Do** – Pastor Chuck taught us that “Christian” means “follower of Christ”, or “belonging to Christ”. Talk about what that means for your family. Write down a list of characteristics you see in Jesus throughout the New Testament, and pray together that God would grow each of those characteristics in your lives.
-  **Pray** – Thank God for the incredible opportunity He gives us to be called His children. If any of your children aren’t saved, pray for God to draw their hearts to Him!

## DAY 2:

-  **Read** – Acts 11:22-23, 2 Corinthians 5:17
-  **Do** – One way people around the New Testament church knew they were Christians (followers of Christ) was the grace they displayed. What is grace? (Feel free to use a dictionary to look up the definition as a family.) Who is the source of grace? How can people see God’s grace in your life as a Christian? Read 2 Corinthians 5:17 together. Parents, share your testimony with your children, focusing on the life transformation that occurred. How could people see that you had changed once you came to know Christ?
-  **Pray** – Thank God for His grace that changes us in a way that shows others His power in our lives.

## DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Acts 11:23-26
-  **Do** – The church in Acts continued in their faith, even when it meant severe opposition and persecution. The Christians continued to grow by immersing themselves in God’s Word and being an active part of the local church. They were determined to grow and be deliberate in Bible study and prayer—anything else was unacceptable. How can you and your family grow as Christians? Make a serious commitment together today to grow in your faith and to stand firm, no matter what.
-  **Pray** – Ask God to give your family strong faith in Him. Ask Him for power to live up to your name as a Christian. Thank Him for the gift of being His ambassador, and ask for strength to represent Him well. Pray for God to bring revival to CFBC!
