



WEEK OF OCTOBER 1-7, 2017

“Jesus can save anybody and turn them into a somebody!”

DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Romans 3:23, Romans 1:28-32
-  **Do** – The world is broken. We try to escape the broken world in many ways. Draw or paint a picture of the world, and then draw a big broken line down the center. Discuss ways that our world is broken. The world is broken because sin has entered the world.
-  **Pray** – Admit to God that you see sin around you and even in your own life. Thank God that this isn't the end of the story!

DAY 2:

-  **Read** – John 3:16, Romans 6:23, 2 Corinthians 5:21
-  **Do** – Even in the midst of our broken world, God still had a plan to fix the world and redeem the people in it. He sent His Son Jesus to save the world. Have your children write out some wrong things that they know they are guilty of. Follow up by discussing how Jesus has taken the blame and the punishment for all the things we have done wrong. Write over the list in a bright red marker, “Jesus paid for this!”
-  **Pray** – Thank God for sending Jesus to die for your sins! Praise Him for holding nothing against you!

DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Romans 10:9, 2 Corinthians 5:17, John 14:6
-  **Do** – If we turn from our ways and trust Jesus as our King, He will restore us back into God's perfect design. Draw the world again. This time, do not draw the broken line on it! Have your children use moldable clay to create a heart, and then have them place the heart on the world. Discuss how God loves the world, and He is the only way to make it perfect again. It is God who shapes us into His perfect design.
-  **Pray** – Thank God for making the world right again! If your children don't already have a relationship with Jesus, pray for God to save them. Ask God to use your family to grow His Kingdom.
