









WEEK OF NOVEMBER 5-11, 2017
"Faith Alone"




DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Romans 3:21-26
-  **Do** – Follow [this link](#) to a maze! Print out enough copies of the maze to have one for each family member. Allow time to complete it. Then discuss as a family the importance of faith. The maze may break off into different dead-ends, but there is only one correct way to complete it. And faith in Jesus Christ is the only path to salvation!
-  **Pray** – Pray together for the salvation of every one of your family members.

DAY 2:

-  **Read** – Acts 4:12
-  **Do** – You know what doesn't work? Eating soup with a fork! Intentionally choose to serve soup for dinner one night this week—but instead of handing out spoons, hand out forks! When it becomes clear that using a fork just doesn't work, talk about it. The reason faith in Jesus is so important is because nothing else works.
-  **Pray** – Thank God for sending Jesus as the only way to get to Him.

DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Ephesians 2:8-9
-  **Do** – Let's play "Uncle"! Invite your child into your lap and wrap them up with your arms like a seatbelt. Challenge them to break out, and say, "When you're ready for me to let you go, say 'Uncle!'" Later on, once everyone has settled down, discuss how we cannot break out of our sins. We need Jesus, and only faith in Him can free us. We cannot free ourselves!
-  **Pray** – Thank God for giving us His Word to allow us to know that He is the only One who can save us from our sins. Pray for our services at CFBC tomorrow, and ask Him to bring revival to our church and community!
