WEEK OF APRIL 23-29, 2017
“That’s My King!”

DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Acts 1:9-11, Revelation 1:17b-18
-  **Do** – Can you guess how old the oldest living person is? See who can get the closest without going over! (Answer: 117 years old) The amazing thing about Jesus is that, after He died and rose from the grave, *He never died again!* Instead, He ascended to Heaven and lives forever!
-  **Pray** – Praise God that JESUS IS ALIVE FOREVER!

DAY 2:

-  **Read** – Psalm 24:7-10
-  **Do** – Jesus is the King of Glory! Talk with your children about what it means to be a king. Now, talk about a concept they might be a little less familiar with—talk about “glory”. What does that word mean? (magnificence, high renown, honor due to achievements) So what does it mean that Jesus is the King of Glory, and how should we respond?
-  **Pray** – Praise Jesus for being the King of Glory! Ask Him to show you how your life should reflect that this week.

DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Hebrews 1:3
-  **Do** – Do a push-up or sit-up challenge! Who in your family can do the most? Even the strongest family member runs out of energy and strength, but Jesus is so great that He NEVER runs out of power!
-  **Pray** – Praise God that He is so strong!

DAY 4:

-  **Read** – Daniel 7:13-14
-  **Do** – Have a family movie night! Put some sleeping bags and pillows on the ground and watch *The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe*. The characters in the movie were sure Aslan was returning because he promised he would, and they saw signs that he was on the move!
-  **Pray** – Praise Jesus that, just as He ascended on the clouds, He will return on the clouds!

DAY 5:

-  **Read** – Matthew 28:18-20
-  **Do** – When a king commissions someone to serve, that person is sent out with all the king’s authority and power. As we begin our Global Missions Emphasis at CFBC tomorrow, talk about our King and how He gives us all His strength and power to accomplish His mission in the world!
-  **Pray** – Ask God to give you His power to live boldly, strategically, and confidently in Him!
