“Kingdom Seekers”




DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Luke 11:2, Romans 14:11
-  **Do** – Draw pictures as a family of your favorite activities and things to do each week. Then take a bowl and place each picture in the bowl. The bowl symbolizes us giving each activity to Jesus! Discuss how Jesus can get His way in every picture and part of our lives.
-  **Pray** – Ask Jesus to help us give Him every area of our life.




DAY 2:

-  **Read** – Mark 1:15, John 3:5
-  **Do** – Use this time to walk through the Gospel with your kids. You can use visual tools like the Bridge, Three Circles, or verbal ways like Creation to Christ.
-  **Pray** – Thank Jesus for bringing the Kingdom of God to earth and dying to give us a way to be included in it..




DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Exodus 15:11, 1 Samuel 2:2, 1 Peter 1:16
-  **Do** – Holiness means being set apart. Take a glass of water with food coloring in it (this represents Christians). Also have a glass of vegetable (this represents the world). Pour the water into the oil and watch as it separates. Discuss how we live set apart for Jesus.
-  **Pray** – Ask God to empower us to live differently from the world.

DAY 4:

-  **Read** – Psalm 77:9-14, James 4:8
-  **Do** – Bake a cake as a family! Have each member have a part in the process. Discuss how, just as the cake batter was transformed into a delicious cake, Jesus transforms our lives!
-  **Pray** – Thank God that He transforms us, and ask that He will continue to make us more like Him!

DAY 5:

-  **Read** – 2 Chronicles 33:1-6, 9-13, 15-16
-  **Do** – Discuss as a family how it is never too late! It doesn't matter what you've done—it is never too late to turn to Jesus.
-  **Pray** – Praise God that Jesus came to live the life we could not live, died, and rose three days later to give us His righteousness!
