Tailgating will be permitted on the campus of Lyon College on September 29, 2018 to provide social gathering opportunities for alumni, families, and fans prior to the start of the game.

Location



Tailgate Alley, south lawn of the Mabee-Simpson Library. Vehicles will be parked in the parking lot above this area. The parking lot will be reserved for vehicles on game day.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. The designated tailgating area/parking lot is open for tailgating five hours before kickoff and closes one hour before kickoff. All areas should be clean before departure.
- 2. Tailgating activities on campus are limited to this area during this four hour period.
- 3. All persons and vehicles are to enter through the designated entrance.
- 4. Tailgating outside the designated tailgating area on campus is not permitted.
- 5. Participants must have a vehicle in the designated tailgating area or be specific guests of Lyon College.
- 6. No person shall sell, give or deliver alcoholic beverages to another person under 21 years of age. Only persons 21 years or older are permitted to consume or possess alcohol.*
- 7. All persons are to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Abusive and/or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- 8. Propane and charcoal grills are permitted. It is expected that hot charcoal be disposed of in designated receptacles. Open flames are prohibited, including fire pits, portable fire places and tiki torches.
- 9. Trash receptacles are provided and all participants are expected to clean up their area.
- 10. Kegs (any size), beer balls, bongs, funnels, or any devices intended to increase alcohol consumption are prohibited.
- 11. Open containers may not be taken outside the designated tailgating area.
- 12. All Lyon College students are reminded that they are subject to the Lyon College Honor Code, the Lyon College Social Code, and all campus rules and regulations.
- 13. In case of emergency, call 911. For assistance in non-emergency situations call Campus Safety at 870-307-SAFE (870-307-7233).

Participants should be aware that abuse and/or failure to comply with this policy will result in an appropriate response from personnel including eviction, barring and/or assistance from local authorities.

*REMINDER: It should be noted that a social host may be liable to guests and others for injuries resulting from serving alcohol especially to a minor.
