She is a founder and currently serves on the board of the Everglades Foundation, having served as vice chairperson from 2003-2012, and chairperson from 1995 to 2002, and is President of The Everglades Trust. Mary also serves on the boards of National Parks Conservation Association, World Wildlife Fund Marine Leadership Committee, WWF National Council, Atlantic Salmon Federation (U.S.), Clean Water Action and Wild Oceans.
