As you probably know, SUPER CAMP is just right around the corner. We will be at Camp ToKnowHim in Pisgah, Alabama. Mark June 10-14 on your calendar, and join us for a week of spiritual growth and good times. Pastor Steve McAlister and I will be leading the sessions this year. The theme is "Press on to Maturity."

The cost of SUPER CAMP is \$225 which includes a T-shirt. All students will have the opportunity to go on an adventurous night hike through the deep caves and caverns of Pisgah, Alabama, for an additional fee of \$12 each. There will also be an opportunity to go on a rappelling adventure for age 14+ for an additional fee of \$15 each. Please turn in your **\$50 non-refundable deposit by May 12** either in a Special Events Envelope in the offering plate, in the Church Office, or to me.

As always, we are in need of adult chaperones to help lead this week of camp. Our chaperones are an essential part of the spiritual growth as well as the fun at camp. If you are a parent who has never been to camp, then strongly consider signing up. As you can tell from many of the baptism testimonies of our students, this week has played a critical role in their spiritual growth. If you have been before, then obviously, you are welcome again.

There is limited room for luggage, so please only bring one bag per person. The bus will leave the church Monday, June 10, at 12:30 p.m. Please be in the Fellowship Hall no later than 12:00 p.m. with your bag loaded under the bus. We will return Friday, June 14, around 1:00 p.m. Students may bring cell phones to communicate with family, but we encourage using it sparingly. We also strongly discourage using social media while at camp. We would like for this to be a time to unplug from electronics to draw closer to the Lord and enjoy face-to-face fellowship with friends at camp. We will have a meeting on Sunday, June 2, following the evening service in the Student Center to tie up any loose ends including paying your balance.

What to bring:

1. Church Liability Release Form (the form that covers you for the entire year)
2. Camp Hold Harmless Agreement Form
3. Bible, notebook, pen
4. Snack money (about \$15)
5. Modest shorts, T-shirts, tennis shoes (**Matthew 18:6-9**)
6. Bathing suits (modest shorts over modest one-piece bathing suits for girls and modest shorts for guys)
7. Bring an extra towel or two for swimming
8. Toiletries
9. Bed linens and pillow
10. Clothes that can get dirty
11. Trash bag/bags for wet or dirty clothing
12. Extra shoes or sandals that can get wet

What NOT to bring:

1. CD players, iPods, or any electronic games or devices!
2. Cigarettes, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, and/or drugs of an addictive nature
3. Fireworks of any kind
4. Paraphernalia for pranks
