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### 2/10/19- 4-1 Judges

#### Bible verses

- Primary passage: Judges 2:11-19
- Judges 7:4-7
- Judges 4:1-10
- Judges 14:5-6

Summary of lesson: In this lesson we discussed how God uses whoever He wants to accomplish His purposes. We take a closer look at Deborah, a female leader in a male dominated society, Gideon a military leader who trusted God's plans, and Sampson a self-promoting man. God used them to show His faithfulness to the people of Israel.

#### Questions to discuss with your kids:

- Have you ever been asked to do something that was out of your comfort zone? How did it go? in the end did you learn something new about you-self?
  - How do you think God can use your talents to be a leader in your schools?
  - Do you ever find yourself acting like Sampson, using your gifts from God to honor yourself? How can you use them to honor God instead?
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### 2/17/19- 4-2 David

#### Bible verses

- Primary passage: 1 Samuel 16:4-13
- Matthew 1:1,17
- 2 Kings 22: 1-2
- Acts 2: 29-31

Summary of lesson: In this lesson we discussed how again God uses whoever he wants to lead his people. In this story God uses David, who was the youngest son of his lowly family and the one who was overlooked. However, David became the greatest king of Israel. Even though he was far from perfect he is often described as a man after God's heart. We further discussed the lineage of David and how it connects to Jesus and his everlasting kingdom.

#### Questions to discuss with your kids:

- Have you ever written someone off, thinking they would not be able to do something, and found out you were totally wrong?
  - What are the ways that we limit ourselves, saying that we are not capable of certain things?
  - Are there any relatives in your family tree that have an interesting story? What is your lineage?
  - What would it look like if people said we were a family after God's own heart?
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### 2/24/19- 4-3 Solomon's Temple

#### Bible verses

- Primary passage: 1 Kings 9:1-9
- Psalm 11:1-7
- Acts 17:24-25
- 2 Samuel 7:1-7

Summary of lesson: In this lesson we discuss how God isn't just a genie in a bottle. He answers our prayers but sometimes it isn't how we expect our prayers to be answered. God is among his people working through his people, even if we can't always see it right away. We further discuss how God can be seen in people all around the world.

Questions to discuss with your kids:

- Have you ever seen God through other people?
  - How can you be a light to people and show them God's love?
  - What are things you are praying for?
  - When you pray, how much of your prayer sounds like a wish list (ex. Please God help me pass, or help \_\_\_\_\_ get better, etc.)? Is this a bad thing to pray like this? What are other things we could talk about with God in prayer?
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
