Summary of lesson: In this lesson we will talk about how we all face struggles in our faith, weather its large issues or small, we all have unanswered questions. We further will discuss how through any difficult times we can rely on god to help us through. God is always there for us even when we disobey him he finds ways to continue to bless us instead.

Questions to discuss with your kids:

- Do you ever question why things happen?
 - Have you ever played seen someone with a cane, walker or crutches? Do they help them when they are hurt? Do you think God is like a crutch to us when we are hurt?
 - Have you ever experienced something that didn't go your way but worked out in the end?
