The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence deeply values all contributions to sustain our mission. This policy explains how we gather, use and protect personal information submitted to us.

Privacy and Security

The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence is committed to respecting the privacy of donors. At NCADV we do not lend, sell or rent mailing lists of our donors or participants personal information to any third party. Donor names, addresses, phone numbers or credit card information will not be used outside of our organization. A donor may choose to remain anonymous at any time. Donors may remove their information from our database by contacting our office at (303) 839-1852.

Information Collected

High grade encryption and https security protocols are used in collecting personal information. NCADV only collects information volunteered by donors during their communication or transaction(s) with us. Examples of information collected include: name, address, phone, email address and giving history. The use and collection of information about donors is limited to that which is necessary to administer our operations.

How we Use that Information

NCADV uses personal information to:

- Acknowledge and provide a tax receipt
- Respond to donor inquiries or questions about our services
- Develop and implement internal marketing and maintain NCADV's donor database
