2. An animal that spends part of the time in the water and part of the time on land.

3. A fish with both eyes on one side of its head.

4. An animal with whiskers.

5. An animal that travels between fresh water and salt water.

6. An animal that can grow back missing limbs.

7. Animals that avoid predators by:

a) hiding among rocks.

b) hiding in the sand.

c) swimming quickly.

d) hiding in grasses.

8. An animal that might be on a restaurant menu.

9. An animal with spiny skin.

10. An animal that lives in a shell.

11. An animal that eats plankton.

12. A man-made object that has become a home for animals in Long Island Sound.

13. An animal that must go to the surface to breathe air.

14. An animal whose mouth is on the underside of its body.

15. An animal that spends most of its time on the bottom.

16. An animal attached to something else.

17. An animal that has no bones.

18. An animal with a beak.

19. An animal that's bigger than you.

20. An animal that has tentacles. (It's not the octopus, which has *arms*.)
