



Wildlife Safari Park Campout Guidelines

Please read before attending the Campouts Program.

The Wildlife Safari Park is located just south of Interstate 80 at exit 426 (about 30 miles west of Omaha).

Since the Wildlife Safari Park (WSP) is closed for the night, you will need to enter through the EXIT gate. Meet your campout leaders outside the front entrance (south side) of the Visitor Center between 6:15 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. If you arrive early, you are welcome to visit the aviary on the north side of the Visitor Center and the Elk Overlook located off the main parking lot. **Late arrivals will not be able to get into the park.** No refunds will be given for late arrivals. After everyone is checked in, our staff will lead you to the Wolf Canyon campsite.

Tentative Schedule

6:15pm-6:30pm	Meet campout leaders at the Visitor’s Center to begin your night!!
6:30-7:30pm	Follow Campout Leaders to Wolf Canyon. Unload gear and hike to campsite.
7:30-11:00pm	Nature hike, activities, campfire, snack, movie.
11:00-11:30pm	Free time, lights out.
6:30am-7:15am	Wake up call. Time for breakfast.
7:15- 8:30am	Morning hike, activities, wrap up.
8:30am	End of program. You are welcome to stay the remainder of the day at the WSP.

- Things to bring:
 - Sleeping bag and pillow
 - Cots (available), blow mattresses and sleeping bag pads are welcome
 - Weather appropriate clothing, good shoes for hiking
 - Flashlight
 - Bug repellent
- We recommend that you have dinner before you arrive. We will provide s’mores at night and a light backpacker’s breakfast (granola bars/pop-tarts). You are welcome to bring your own cooler with drinks, snacks, etc. Coolers with wheels work the best.
- Please remember that you are responsible for carrying everything you bring to your camping location. The park does not provide transportation or wagons. There is a decent walk uphill from the parking lot to the campsite so please consider packing as lightly as you can.
- **Alcohol is not allowed at the Wildlife Safari Park.**
- The WSP is a tobacco-free facility. **There is NO SMOKING ALLOWED at the Wildlife Safari Park.**
- All adults are responsible for following the WSP rules and enforcing rules with the children.
